- Established by state statute as an independent, neutral office in the Utah Department of Commerce that safeguards the property rights of the citizens of Utah through <u>education</u> and <u>dispute</u> <u>resolution</u>
- Assists citizens and government agencies in understanding and complying with property rights laws, resolves disputes, and advocates fairness and balance when private rights conflict with public needs
